Reimbursement of the cost of books lying unsold due to abolition of optional subjects from the curriculum of Class- IX & X.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to the subject cited above and to say that consequent upon withdrawal of optional subjects from the curriculum of Class-IX & X a number of optional books are reported lying unsold with the book sellers as well as in the stock of Board of Secondary Education. This has resulted non co-operation of the Registered Book Sellers for lifting of Text Books during the academic year 2009-10.

After careful consideration Govt. have been pleased to decide that the cost of the books will be compensated and the books will be sent to the schools for use of reference books. In order to workout the above decision the following steps are required to be taken.

1. The Board of Secondary Education at the first instance shall evaluate the actual no. of books and cost thereof lying unsold with the registered book sellers out of the Books sold during 2008-09 and intimate the same to Govt. and Director, Secondary Education.
2. The Director, Secondary Education shall furnish the list of Govt. High Schools (both new and old) and no. of books category wise to be supplied to each school to the Board of Secondary Education. Necessary instructions shall also be issued to the Headmaster of such schools to receive the above books from the book sellers as reference books.
3. The Board of Secondary Education shall issue necessary instructions to the registered book sellers to supply the required no. of books to the Headmasters of such schools with triplicate chalan.

4. The Headmaster of such schools after receiving the books will enter in their stock register and forward a copy of the chalan alongwith stock entry certificate on the body of the same to the Director, Secondary Education.
5. The registered book sellers shall also submit another copy of the chalan to the Board who in turn will issue new printed books of Class-IX & X on a cost basis.
6. The Board of Secondary Education shall furnish a copy of the chalan to the Director, Secondary Education and the Director, Secondary Education after verification of the chalan received from the concerned Headmaster and from the Board will send necessary proposal to Govt. for reimbursement of the cost.
7. The Board of Secondary Education will also supply the books available at their level to the High Schools in consultation with the Director, Secondary Education in the above process. However the concerned Inspector of Schools shall countersign the challan regarding stock entry.

You are therefore requested to take steps in the matter immediately and report compliance before 31st December, 2009 to this Deptt. in order to enable this Deptt. to take further action.
